In stages, he is learning more and more about wood, joinery, design, and finishing. Each project is a step along the way. (Tomorrow's project is always waiting...)


WELCOME

HARDWOOD LUMBER

Our new 2000 square foot Hardwood Lumber Room in the downstairs area of our hardware store allows you to choose from among thousands of board feet of hard-to-find species of lumber. Walnut, oak, mahogany, cherry, maple, ash and wormy chestnut are all generally here in large quantities, planed on two sides and displayed vertically in racks. Beech, basswood, mulberry, sycamore, butternut, poplar and white pine are also currently available and on display.

Our shop consists of a separate 1000 square foot basement room which houses our old 20" thickness planer, now powered by a more modern 5 HP motor, and our 8" longbed jointer. These machines serve the production of smoothly dressed hardwood lumber from the rough-cut boards which we receive from the sawmill.

More lumber is stored in our accelerated air drying shed adjacent to the store. The air in this room is constantly heated and circulated among the stacks of lumber, enabling us to buy the lumber directly from the sawmill, season it ourselves, and offer it to you at down to earth prices.

I would like to offer our thanks to Leon Colwell, whose inspiration and ability to constantly discover quantities of beautiful hardwood has enabled us to develop such a large lumber inventory.

In addition to the fine hand tools, stationary power tools, and hardwood lumber, our hardware store offers a broad line of stains, finishes, strippers, solvents, and adhesives. WATCO Danish oil, Deft, Minwax, Tung oil, Butcher's Wax are a few of the products we carry. Our discount prices on Strypeeze, Kutzit, H₂Off, and Savogran Superstrip take some of the pain out of furniture stripping and refinishing.


